



Use of Open Spaces policy

Rogate Parish Council owns four parcels of land:

- Fyning Recreation Ground (registered Village Green)
- Oliver's Piece
- Rake Recreation Ground, Bull Hill (registered Village Green)
- Terwick Woodland

Regulations which apply to Village Greens (section 29 of the Commons Act 1876, together with section 12 of the Inclosure Act 1857 and subsequent amendments) have been incorporated in this policy for all our Open Spaces.

These Open Spaces are for the recreational use and enjoyment of local people who:

- can freely use the Open Space for their recreation
- act within the law and must not cause any damage
- respect and not damage or harm the wildlife, their habitat, trees or wildflowers
- don't have to pay to use the Open Spaces (but may be asked for a donation)

Visitors are not permitted to:

- Camp
- Light a fire or have a barbecue
- Lay garden waste, manure, soil, ashes or rubbish
- Hold a festival or other event
- Drive across it
- Take animals on to the open space who may cause damage
- Damage fences
- Interrupt others' use or enjoyment of the space
- Fence in any part of the open space
- Put up any structure including tents
- Disturb the soil of the open space
- Extend the boundary of their property on to the open space
