



3) Co-option application form received from David Seddon.

10) Meeting at Rake Village Hall – to agree to meet at Rake village hall (instead of Rogate) once a year – initially on second Monday of April in 2024.

11) Youth Club funds – following receipt of £5,653.56 last month which is ring fenced for the youth of Rogate – any suggestions welcome.

12) Speed limit application updates

- a) **Fyning 20mph TRO** – still waiting for a response as to whether or not application passed on the other criteria (safety, access, costs and environment). We were aware a 20mph was possible a starting point - do we want to make another application for a 30mph?
- b) **Hillbrow 30mph TRO** – passed first and second assessment so has proceeded to next stage to arrange and assess speed data.
- c) **Rogate village CHS** – update not expected for months but note what appeared to be speed measuring devices were recently fitted on all entrance roads into the village centre.
