

Pop Up Lunch

This monthly event, on the first Wednesday, continues to be enjoyed by all who attend, whether as lunchers or members of the volunteer team. The meals are healthy, using fresh ingredients, and varying dietary needs are met wherever possible.

Up to 40 people attend regularly (over 50 at the Christmas lunch!) and the volume of chatter suggests that they are enjoying the social interaction. Once again the school came to our Christmas lunch and sang some Christmas songs, which delighted those attending.

The cost of food and drink continue to increase and the price per lunch has had to be increased to £6 for a two course meal plus tea and coffee, and a donation of £3 is suggested for each glass of wine. Still extremely good value.

This is almost the sole survivor of what used to be a healthy number of village groups and as long as people are keen to attend, the volunteers will keep up the food preparation.

The 'lunchers' are regularly bringing in non-perishable items for the two foodbanks (in Liss and in Midhurst) that we are supporting each month.
